On April 18, 2018 at 2:00 p.m., the Yuma County Board of Commissioners met via teleconference for a special meeting. Chairman Trent Bushner, Commissioner Robin Wiley, Commissioner Dean Wingfield, and Administrator Andrea Calhoon were present throughout the meeting.


Leave of Absence Request – Yuma County Road and Bridge Supervisor JR Colden joined the teleconference and presented a request for a leave of absence for Road and Bridge employee, Gale Reynolds who satisfied all FMLA use in April 2018. **Commissioner Wiley moved to approve a 30 day Leave of Absence for Gale Reynolds following the expiration of FMLA eligibility. Commissioner Wingfield seconded and the motion passed by unanimous vote.**

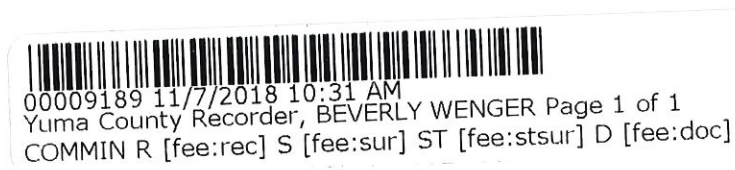
