

There are many things happening in the Yuma County Treasurer's. The tax collection season is wrapping up and we are 95.64% collected as of July 17th. Delinquent notices were sent out at the beginning of July and the remaining payments are beginning to come in.

If you own a mobile home or pay personal property taxes on your business we will be requiring certified funds for those payment beginning on August 14th. The advertising list for all unpaid mobile homes and personal property will be sent to the papers on September 1st and the publication will run on September 13th and 14th.

If you still owe taxes on real property, including severed minerals, we will be requiring certified funds for payment beginning September 1st. The advertising list for all unpaid real property and severed minerals will be sent to the newspapers September 29th and will be published for three consecutive weeks in the official county paper, The Yuma Pioneer, on October 12th, 19th, and 26th. The publication will also run for one week on October 11th, in the Wray Gazette. The delinquent list will be available at yumacounty.net on the Treasurer's home page.

All remaining delinquent mobile homes will be distrained the week of October 9th. Delinquent personal property businesses will also be visited and may be distrained at that time.

The 2017 Tax Lien Sale will be an internet auction and the dates are November 6th through November 8th. The auction website is www.zeusauction.com. Bidder registration will begin on October 16th and will close on November 3rd. The auction opens at 8:00 a.m. on November 6th and will close at 5:00 p.m. on November 8th. There will be some bidder training available a couple of weeks before the sale. Please check the county website for the dates and times. Mobile homes will NOT be sold on the internet sale. They will be sold in the Treasurer's office beginning at 10:30 a.m. on November 8th.
