Horse Race Rules for Yuma County Horse Races

- All horses running must be entered on the day before each race day. Entries will be taken at the Race Barn Office between 4:00 pm and 6:00 pm the night before each race day. Call in entries accepted at 970-630-2680 (Cell)
- Added money plus entry fees will be divided between top three finishers (50% - 30% - 20%).
- Any person who enters will be required to complete a W-9 form at time of entry.
- Four Horses must enter and three must run. No entry fees will be refunded for any reason!!!
- 2 Yr. olds must have been born in 2017. **Copies of both sides of registration papers required.**
- Jocks must tack at least 110 lbs. and must furnish their own weights.
- Race conditions subject to change by Racing Supt. and all judges' decisions are final with no appeal

Yuma County Cowhorse Race Rules

- 250 Yds. \$300 Added Money \$20 entry fee Limited to 6 horses
- Rider must be at least 18 years old and must be a resident of Yuma County.
- No race horses allowed in Yuma County Cowhorse race.
- Equipment Requirements: stock saddle - - bridle with shank bit - - no racing plates - - no tattoo
- Horses will walk westward and at the starters signal will turn around and race to the finish line.
