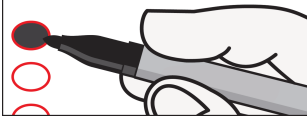

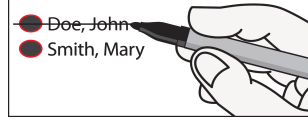
**INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTERS:**

**Making selections**

**Optional Write-in**



To vote for a qualified write-in candidate, write the person's name in the blank space provided and FILL IN THE OVAL to the left.

**WARNING:** Any person who, by use of force or other means, unduly influences an eligible elector to vote in any particular manner or to refrain from voting, or who falsely makes, alters, forges or counterfeits any mail ballot before or after it has been cast, or who destroys, defaces, mutilates, or tampers with a ballot is subject, upon conviction, to imprisonment, or to a fine, or both. **Ballot Measures**

Ballot questions referred by the general assembly or any political subdivision are listed by letter, and ballot questions initiated by the people are listed numerically. A ballot question listed as an "amendment" proposes a change to the Colorado constitution, and a ballot question listed as a "proposition" proposes a change to the Colorado Revised Statutes. A "yes/for" vote on any ballot question is a vote in favor of changing current law or existing circumstances, and a "no/against" vote on any ballot question is a vote against changing current law or existing circumstances.

**Proposition CC (STATUTORY)**

WITHOUT RAISING TAXES AND TO BETTER FUND PUBLIC SCHOOLS, HIGHER EDUCATION, AND ROADS, BRIDGES, AND TRANSIT, WITHIN A BALANCED BUDGET, MAY THE STATE KEEP AND SPEND ALL THE REVENUE IT ANNUALLY COLLECTS AFTER JUNE 30, 2019, BUT IS NOT CURRENTLY ALLOWED TO KEEP AND SPEND UNDER COLORADO LAW, WITH AN ANNUAL INDEPENDENT AUDIT TO SHOW HOW THE RETAINED REVENUES ARE SPENT?

#### Yuma School District 1 Ballot Issue 4G

SHALL YUMA SCHOOL DISTRICT-1 DEBT BE INCREASED \$16 MILLION, WITH A REPAYMENT COST OF UP TO \$25.7 MILLION, AND SHALL DISTRICT TAXES BE INCREASED BY UP TO \$1.3 MILLION ANNUALLY FOR THE PAYMENT OF A GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND ISSUED TO THE STATE TO PROVIDE LOCAL MATCHING MONEY REQUIRED FOR THE DISTRICT TO RECEIVE AN ADDITIONAL EQUAL AMOUNT OF \$15,968,229 IN AWARDED "BEST" GRANT FUNDS (WHICH ARE NOT REQUIRED TO BE REPAYED) TO FINANCE HEALTH, SAFETY AND SECURITY NEEDS OF THE DISTRICT INCLUDING:

- IMPROVING STUDENT SAFETY BY RECONFIGURING PARENT AND BUS PICK-UP AND DROP-OFF LOCATIONS AT THE ELEMENTARY, MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOLS;
- CONSTRUCTING AN ADDITION TO THE HIGH SCHOOL AND RENOVATING THE EXISTING FACILITY TO, AMONG OTHER THINGS, ENHANCE THE SECURITY OF THE FACILITY AND IMPROVE CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION;
- REPAIRING OR REPLACING OUTDATED HVAC, ELECTRICAL AND OTHER MECHANICAL SYSTEMS IN THE HIGH SCHOOL AND MIDDLE SCHOOL; AND
- RENOVATING THE MIDDLE SCHOOL SERVING KITCHEN;

WHICH GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND SHALL BEAR INTEREST, MATURE, BE SUBJECT TO REDEMPTION, WITH OR WITHOUT PREMIUM, AND BE ISSUED AT SUCH TIME-AND IN SUCH MANNER AND CONTAINING SUCH TERMS, NOT INCONSISTENT WITH THIS BALLOT ISSUE, AS THE BOARD OF EDUCATION MAY DETERMINE; AND SHALL AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAXES BE LEVIED WITHOUT LIMIT AS TO THE MILL RATE TO GENERATE AN AMOUNT SUFFICIENT IN EACH YEAR TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF, PREMIUM IF ANY, AND INTEREST ON SUCH DEBT AND TO FUND ANY RESERVES FOR THE PAYMENT THEREOF?
