APPLICATION REQUESTS

Please submit the following items, in the following sequence:

- 1. A check for \$50.00 for each well permit.
- **2.** Completed Yuma County Permit Ordinance 1982-1. It needs to be signed and include the contact information on the company applying for the permit, and the name of the drilling company.
- **3.** Proof of surface owner notification (that is <u>signed</u> by the owner), must be attached at the time of submission to be deemed complete. Permits submitted without <u>signed</u> proof of surface owner notification will not be approved and will be returned. A" Certified Mail Receipt" signed by the surface owners will meet this requirement.
- **4.** Copy of your companies "Notice of the Intent to Drill" letter, addressed to the surface owner pursuant to Rule 303(1) of the Rules & Regs of the Oil & Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado.
- **5.** Copy of the "State of Colorado Oil and Gas Application for Permit". (Form #2)
- **6.** Copy of "Drill Site/Access Road Reclamation Form" with appropriate attachments. (Form #2A) (Legal Notification)
- **7.** Copy of topography map, (if available, not required).
- **8.** Copy of Oil and Gas Lease, (if available, not required).
- **9.** Any information you feel may be pertinent to your permit.
