

NEW Parade Procedures, Rules & Regulations

- Entries are open to Yuma County and trade area residents. Entrants are asked to read the following carefully:
- The YCF Parade Committee is requiring all entries, including horses and with the exception of the children's division who wish to be judged for a prize you will need to be pre-registered.
- The deadline for pre-registering will be 4:00 PM-~~noon~~ on Monday, August 9th and the parade entries forms must be dropped off at the Yuma District Hospital, Yuma 4-H Food Booth, or give to an YCF Parade Committee member, or at the 4-H Extension Fair Office at the Yuma County Fairgrounds, or Treia at the Yuma County 4-H Food Booth.

- ******* ALL ESQUESTRIN TEAMS MUST PROVIDE TWO WALKERS*******
- All floats should be clearly labeled as to sponsorship, whether an organization or individual.
- Prize money will be awarded to the winners. *See note at bottom of page.
- Floats will be judged before the parade and winners will be designated by signs.
- --Antique/Classic/Auto vehicles are invited to join the parade. You must be parked on East side of Main Street across from the NJC Bldg, Yuma Campus..
- *The YCF Parade Committee prefers that participants hand out candy or other items only by individuals walking along the sidewalk and curb.*
- *Prizes will be forfeited if any rules are not followed!*
- All floats will be judged at 9:00 AM. You must be completely set up prior to judging. If you wish to be considered for a cash prize, you must be in line at 9:00 AM, no exceptions, and pre-registered before the deadline.
- There will be no duplication of prizes. Non-competing commercial entries and others not competing for prizes are welcome to be in the parade and will be placed among the other entries at the parade committee's discretion.
- The YCF Parade Committee reserves the right to deny admissions into the parade for just cause. Objectionable features include anything offensive, unworthy or improper for exhibit.
- See the Yuma County Fair Book for more detailed information.
- Any questions may be referred to the YCF Parade Committee.
- Check the Yuma Pioneer and Wray Gazette for the parade route.
