#### **Minutes**

Terry Hofmeister moved to approve the May meeting minutes, and Kevin Blankenship seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

### **COAC Updates**

The COAC announced that there will be a second round of Infrastructure funding. The RFP will be released later in the year, likely in August or September.

## **Financial Reports**

Yuma County reviewed the financial report and gave updates on funding allocations to OMNI and the RFP grantees.

## **OMNI Evaluation Updates**

OMNI noted that the evaluation report for Quarter 2 (January – March 2024) will be shared at the July meeting. The results show large improvements in outcomes from Quarter 1 to Quarter 2.

#### **Jail-Based MOUD Service Funding**

At the last meeting, the board approved funding for jail-based MOUD service in Region 4 jails. At this meeting, there was a discussion of the preferred way to draft contracts for each jail. Jails will provide invoices to the Council, and the Council will reimburse the jails for MOUD services. OMNI will work with providers to collect evaluation data for the funding.

## **Treatment and Recovery RFP Announcement**

It was announced that the Colorado Roots proposal was selected to receive funding. Commissioner Weaver and the Board showed appreciation for all the submissions and the work everyone is doing in the region.

## **Opioid Conference**

A discussion was held about the upcoming COAC conference, which will be held on September 30, 2024, in Loveland, Colorado. Region 4 will be spotlighted at the conference, and members of the Region 4 Board will participate in panel discussions.

COAC requested that Region 4 sponsor the event. Gordon Westhoff moved to sponsor the event at the \$7,000 level. Kevin Blankenship seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

## **Upcoming Grants/Funding Opportunities**

OMNI presented several new grant opportunities available. Grants are posted to the Region 4 website.

The group discussed potential partnerships and organizations that can support grant writing in the Region.

#### <u>Unscheduled Business</u>

Sheriff Martin will host a theater showing of Steffan Tubb's documentary on the Fentanyl crisis in Colorado on June 29th at 11:00 a.m.

To build off of previous discussions on potential Prevention strategies, an example of successful school-based prevention work was given of CSU's Prevention and Social Emotional Learning Program funded by Region 2.

The September meeting will have to be rescheduled. OMNI will work with the Board to find a new date and time.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:00 am.
