- Beer Garden/ Security: Plan has passed through commissioners and they are working on paperwork. Security will be the same as last year.
- Activities: Bands are set and will be advertised. Teen dance will be Saturday night at Old Threshers. Another group will run the dance, but the fair board will pay for the DJ.
- Budget: Not much has changed. Expenses are at about 15,000
- Parade: Sweepstakes are increased to \$300.
- Livestock/Sale: Committee is working on picking photographers. The committee will need to put sale invites together and other various office expenses for fair. Asking to be able to spend money out of the sale fund. Dave moved to let them spend money to get supplies for fair. Jessica seconded and the motion passed. 141 exhibitors entered in beef, swine, goat, and sheep.
- Youth Development: Updates on participants and discussion on external funding sources we need to make kids aware of moving forward.

New Business:

There was a question about non profits getting to use the arena for free. To maintain grants/other funding and to comply with policy outlined for fairgrounds, all nonprofits pay 25% of regular fee. Tom is going to check prices and with IT options for getting TV's in barn.
