Round 4 Infrastructure Funding Opportunity

Application submission deadline: January 14, 2026

Purpose: The purpose of the Infrastructure Share is to promote capital improvements and provide operational assistance for developing and improving the infrastructure necessary to abate the opioid crisis in Colorado. The Infrastructure Share is further intended to meet the needs of rural and underserved populations.

Funding Amount : Up to \$11 million in total available funding

Eligibility: According to the MOU, eligible Applicants for the Infrastructure Share include: • Local governments that participated in the Colorado Opioids Settlement MOU1 • Colorado State Agencies/state government entities • Colorado Regional Opioid Abatement Councils (ROACs), which were formed as a result of the MOU and have a Colorado governmental entity serving as the Fiscal Agent.

Resilient Colorado Grant

Application submission deadline: December 18, 2025

Purpose: The Department of Law is seeking applications from eligible entities who aim to support local and statewide efforts to prevent and respond to opioid use and its impact in Colorado. This funding opportunity is from the State Share of Opioid Settlement Funds. There are six possible target focus areas:

- Target 1: Promoting Youth Well-Being and Prevention by Encouraging Connection and Healthy Behaviors
- Target 2: Addressing Gaps in Substance Use Treatment for Youth
- Target 3: Growing Colorado's Rural & Underserved Behavioral Health Workforce
- Target 4: Building Recovery & Reentry Systems for Justice-Involved Individuals
- Target 5: Supporting Families, Caregivers, and Children
- Target 6: Empowering and Sustaining Colorado Peer Leadership

Funding Amount : Up to \$12 million in total available funding

Eligibility: Eligible entities for the Resilient Colorado grant include: • Colorado county • Colorado municipality • Colorado State agency • Colorado's Federally Recognized Tribes • Colorado Regional Opioid Abatement Council as defined by and formed as a result of the MOU • School, school district, and/or Board of Cooperative Education Services (BOCES) • Non-profit organization, in good standing with the Colorado Secretary of State • For-profit organization, in good standing with the Colorado Secretary of State

Colorado Community Initiated Solutions Grants

Deadline: February 15, 2025

Purpose: The Colorado Health Foundation provides funding for projects that directly engage community members to identify health challenges and implement solutions that meet the specific needs of their communities.

Organizations are required to work collaboratively with community members to:

- Address a health challenge
- Develop and implement a solution
- Leverage existing strengths and resources
- Improve health equity
- Priority will be given to projects that advance health equity or that center on communities of color.
- Areas of Focus: Community Health
- Amount of Funding: Not stated

Eligibility: Eligible applicants include:

- Community based groups or nonprofit organizations with 501(c)(3) status
- Organizations that can demonstrate a substantial commitment to community-identified and community-led efforts to address complex health-related issues and/or challenges
- Organizations without 501(c)(3) status may apply through a fiscal sponsor.
